

## **Basic Rules**

### **1. “Go For It!” Vote for your favorite high school. The High School that receives the most votes will receive a screening of “Go For It!”.**

Follow the instructions on [www.eventful.com/goforit](http://www.eventful.com/goforit) (the “**Website**”) to “vote” for one of the High Schools featured on the Website (each, a “**High School**”). Voting begins March 31, 2011 and ends on May 2, 2011 (the “**Voting Period**”). **Limit one (1) vote per person during the Voting Period.** Votes for each High School will be tracked by the Website. Any rankings or vote counts posted on the Website are unofficial and should not be relied upon for any purpose. The High School that receives the most votes during the Voting Period will receive the screening of “Go For It!” described below. In the event of a tie between two High Schools, the tie will be broken by criteria selected by Pantelion Films (“**Pantelion**”) in its sole and absolute discretion. Pantelion’s decisions are final and binding and not subject to challenge or appeal.

Only legal U.S. residents of the fifty (50) United States and the District of Columbia who are thirteen (13) years of age or older and enrolled at one of the participating High Schools at the time of entry are eligible to vote.

The screening consists of one (1) private screening for up to two hundred (200) students at the selected High School of the movie “Go For It!” (the “**Screening**”). The location of the Screening will be booked in a location selected by Pantelion in its sole discretion. The specific date, time and location of the Screening will be at the sole discretion of Pantelion. If the High School is unwilling, for any reason, to receive the Screening as described and in accordance with these Official Rules, the Screening may be forfeited in its entirety and Pantelion may select an alternate High School to receive the Screening. The High School will be responsible for determining which students attend the Screening. All other expenses and costs including, but not limited to the cost of transportation to and from the Screening for the guests, beverages, snacks and/or purchases during the Screening are the responsibility of the guests attending the Screening. Children attending the Screening must be accompanied by adult chaperones. Guests attending the Screening must be age appropriate for the film. Any Screening details not specified above will be determined by Pantelion in its sole discretion. Screening participants may be required to execute an Affidavit of Eligibility, a Liability Release, and (where imposing such condition is legal) a Publicity Release.
